I am going to HLC to get my haircut. I might have to wait my turn when I get there.




Mary will be cutting my hair. She is great at cutting hair!





I might also see Ms. Zulema, Ms. Sara, and Ms. Kellie at HLC.






When it's my turn for my haircut, I will go into the swing room.



I might wear a cape over my shirt. The cape can catch some of my hairs when Mary cuts them.




To cut my hair, Mary might use a spray bottle and scissors.




She might also use clippers. I might hear and feel the buzzing on my head. It might sound loud or feel funny.
